



Three easy steps...

Weep holes are created by omitting the mortar in the vertical joints at the bottom of an exterior brick wall during construction. A cavity is provided between the outside and the inside space of an exterior wall. This type of structure is called a cavity wall.

Weep holes allow ventilation and the space between the bricks and the frame walls to breathe. Also, any moisture within the cavity due to condensation or flooding can drain through the weep hole openings. Flooding in your home or business can occur during a water heater accident, a water pipe break, or by other means.

This cavity typically extends up to the overhang framing of the roof. These weep holes and the cavity are a perfect invitation to numerous types of insects such as bees, earwigs, lizards, millipedes, pill bugs, roaches, scorpions, spiders or snakes. These critters seek sustenance, refuge, warmth, or a dark perfect living environment. Accessibility to the inside of your home or business is through electrical outlet boxes, light fixtures, plumbing, and a/c duct grills.

The design and intent of Bug Out Weep Hole Insect Barriers is twofold. Of utmost concern is the importance of allowing the weep holes and the cavity space to perform as intended. The main consideration is to prevent undesirable pests access to the cavity from the weep hole opening and ultimately to the family living areas inside your home or business.



Clean inside of weep hole from any debris or excess concrete left during construction.

Surface must be clean and dry. If foundation extends beyond brick wall or if weep hole is located on patio or walk, a breakaway tab is located at bottom of housing to allow the weep hole to be fully opened. Simply push tab out at bottom.



Apply acrylic latex caulk around flat surface at back of housing.

Bond housing to brick wall and directly align over opening of weep hole.

Make sure the housing is completely sealed around the weep hole. Clean out any excess acrylic latex caulk from weep hole opening.
